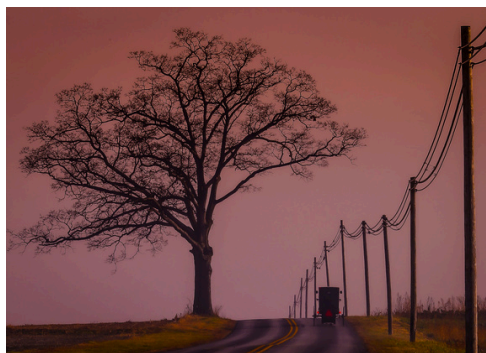

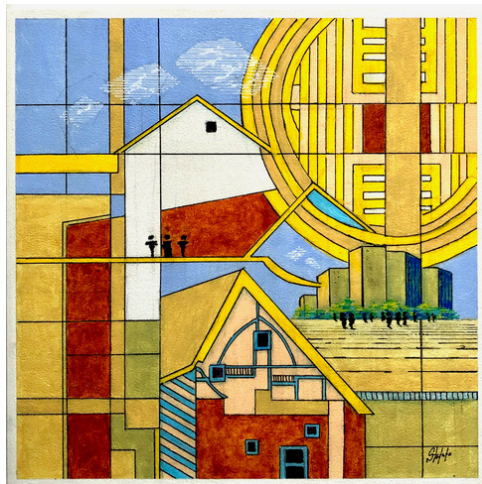

Photography is my life-long passion. My work is meant to evoke thought about both the mundane and the special moments in our lives. My efforts in photography allow me to bring meaning to the medium.



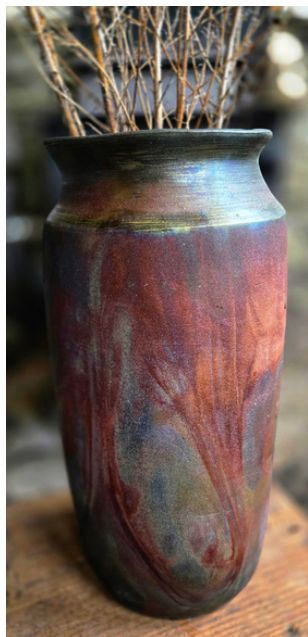

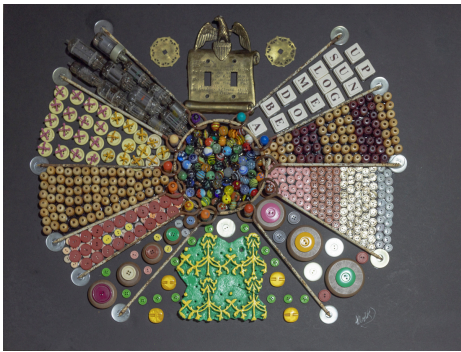
